As my tenure as the President of the ABT comes to its end I find myself reflecting on a very interesting and sometimes frustrating year. I have not been able to venture over to the USA for our usual meetings and have had to conduct my Presidency virtually which has certainly had its moments. I have to acknowledge my Vice President Nicole Soucy who has stepped in when I could not be present in person. Despite these restrictions we have made great strides during the year. We held the first electronic exam which was largely successful despite a small number of candidates facing issues. One of the advantages of the electronic exam was that it provided us with a wealth of data on timings as well as metrics for the questions. Looking at this data we were able to investigate whether it would be possible to reduce the seat time while keeping the integrity of the qualification. After having a reliability study performed, we found that the difference in performance would be negligible but the benefits huge. Therefore, beginning with the 2022 exam we will reduce seat time which will ease the problems with scheduling the exam.

We have also moved from the traditional certificates to a digital badging system and you all should have received your new badge. This is another step we have taken to modernise and allows you to display the badge on LinkedIn and in your email signature when permissible.

We welcomed 196 new Diplomates this year which was so exciting after the disappointment of the cancellation in 2020 and also recertified 413 Diplomates. Congratulations to all of you!

I leave the board this year reflecting on a joyous four years. It has been hard work and stressful at times but the board has always pulled together and we have laughed so much during the period. My abiding memory will be karaoke at the summer board meeting after the business of the day was complete. I have never laughed so much. It has been a true honour to serve on the board and I know I am leaving it in extremely capable hands.

# Treasurer's Report

The ABT had a great financial year in 2021. Total revenue for the year was \$380,497 and expenses were \$319,483, resulting in a surplus of \$61,014. Compared to 2020, our revenue and expenses were 73% and 55% higher, respectively. The primary driver for the higher revenue was the increase in certification fees associated with the transition to computer-based testing centers in 2021. The primary drivers for increased expenses in 2021 were exam expenses, particularly given the move to the electronic format, as well as expenses associated the second Practice Analysis.



Thanks to a strong year for the stock market and our investment advisors, Lynx Investment Advisory, LLC (Lynx), our investment account had an 8.7% return last year. At the end of the 2021 calendar year, the investment account had a value of \$822,959. Since Lynx became the investment advisor for ABT in September 2016, our investment account has had an annualized rate of return of 10.1% and has increased in value by \$311,088. Though the stock market is off to a rough start in 2022, I am confident that Lynx will help ABT navigate these choppy market waters effectively. I have quarterly calls with Lynx to stay abreast of current issues related to the ABT investment portfolio, and any necessary actions to adjust to market conditions.

The Board has approved the 2022 ABT budget of \$366,615 in revenue and \$354,658 in expenses, with an anticipated surplus of \$11,957. The budgeted revenue is a slight decrease over 2021 (-3.6%), while the budgeted expenses are a sizeable increase year-over-year (+9.9%). The drop in 2022 revenue is largely driven by an anticipated decrease in certification fees given the larger than normal number of exam takers in 2021, while the increase in 2022 expenses is tied to multiple areas that are forecasted to be more expensive given the strong inflationary period we are experiencing. A lot of lessons were learned in planning and executing the 2021 ABT budget. The year had appreciable uncertainty around revenue and expenses associated with the certification exam (e.g., the number of exam takers in 2021, the move to an electronic format). Leveraging the experiences of 2021, the Board has high confidence in our 2022 budget projections. However, we will continuously monitor revenue and expenses in this inflationary period to promote financial responsibility and pivot if necessary.

As I wrap up my first year as the ABT Treasurer, I want to extend my gratitude to Don Stump, the previous ABT Treasurer for the past 3 years, who handed me an organization in solid financial shape. Additionally, I would be remiss if I did not acknowledge the adept efforts of Masten Management, Lynx, and the ABT Board in providing the support and guidance needed in supporting me as Treasurer.

# 2022 Examination Changes

The ABT Board has continued to diligently work on ensuring the ABT examination follows best practices in the certification industry. After the 2021 first-ever computer-based examination, the Board was able to collect much data surrounding the time taken by candidates on each question. The Board reviewed this data and the results of the completed second toxicology practice analysis. After consulting with psychometricians, the Board engaged ACT Pro-Exam to conduct a reliability study to investigate the impact of reducing the test length of the ABT certification examination (DABT exam). One of the benefits of reducing the length of the exam that the Board felt was important was reduced seat time at testing centers, which would in turn increase scheduling options for candidates and a reduction in the examination fee.

The study results showed that an examination of 140 scored items will produce essentially similar psychometric properties to those produced by the current 200-item DABT exam. The study and review of data from the 2021 examination also supported a testing time frame of three to four hours for 150-170 total items, allowing time to add “pre-test” items. These are questions that are not scored, but performance statistics are gathered to gauge appropriateness for use on future examinations.

The Board would like to ensure Diplomates that the shortened examination decision was not made lightly. Care was taken to follow the steps necessary to ensure the ABT exam will continue to be a globally recognized credential in toxicology representative of competency and commitment to human health and environmental sciences.
